POLICY:

1. Child Care Resources and Referral Services (CCR&R) will be provided in accordance with Chapter 411.0101 F.S., Rule 60BB-9.300, F.A.C., the Agency for Workforce Innovations Child Care Resource and Referral Services Program Requirements, and applicable Coalition policies and procedures.
2. CCR&R staff are responsible for providing information to the public on existing public and private child care and early childhood education programs and services, including child care services by public and private employers, family day care, head start, prekindergarten early intervention programs, special education programs for prekindergarten handicapped children, services for children with developmental disabilities, full-time and part-time programs, before-school and after-school programs, vacation care programs, parent education, the WAGES Program, and related community family support services.
3. CCR&R staff will respond to all requests for information. Responses to parents are to be provided with recognition of the confidentiality rights of the parent.
4. CCR&R services are free to the public and provided to all families without regard for income.
